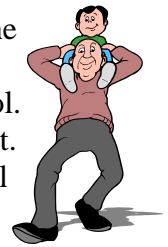

*There are 594 chapters before **Psalms 118** and there are 594 chapters after **Psalms 118**.*

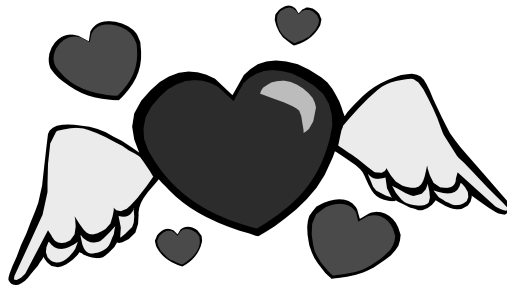
Add 594+594 and you get 1188.
