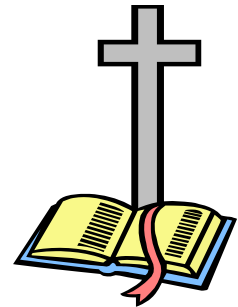

Dear Parents and Families,

Every year, Jesus' family traveled to Jerusalem for Passover. *"After the feast was over (when Jesus was twelve years old), while his parents were returning home, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem, but his parents were unaware of it....After three days, they found him in the temple courts, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions. Everyone who heard him was amazed at his understanding and his answers....His mother said to him, 'Son, why have you treated us like this? Your father and I have been anxiously searching for you.' 'Why were you searching for me?' he said. 'Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's house?'"*

Luke 2:41-49
