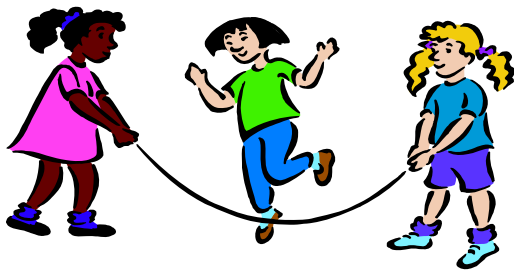
Friends of the Library

Today, children and adults in the United States don't get as much physical activity as they should. At least 30 minutes of moderate physical activity on most days of the week is the recommended minimum. However, nearly 23 percent of children¹ and nearly 40 percent of adults² get no free-time physical activity at all.
