Dear Parents and Families,

Jesus said, "If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over. But if he will not listen, take one or two others along, so that 'every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses.' If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if he refuses to listen even to the church, treat him as you would a pagan or a tax collector." Matthew 18:15-17

In this passage, God gives us clear instructions on how to handle a situation in which someone has wronged us:

1. Go to your brother/sister and tell them what is wrong.
2. If nothing changes, or they won't listen, bring a couple of witnesses along and try again.
3. If they still won't listen, tell it to the church (or anyone in authority). Such a simple plan, but we often forget God's perfect plan and we are sorely tempted to blow up or talk behind that person's back; anything besides going to the person who has wronged us in Christian love and calmly talking and working toward resolution. What a difference it would make in all of our lives if all of us could whole-heartedly strive to do things God's way!

Overweight and obesity, especially among children, have emerged as serious threats to our nation's health. They have risen rapidly among women, men and children of all racial and ethnic groups. And this trend is projected to continue.

Obesity is a major modifiable risk factor for cardiovascular disease. It also increases the potential for high blood cholesterol, high blood pressure and type 2 diabetes, which are each major risk factors for cardiovascular disease and other serious health problems. Recent research suggests that obesity shortens the average lifespan by at least four to nine months, and if childhood obesity continues to increase, it could cut two to five years from the average lifespan. That could cause our current generation of children to become the first in American history to live shorter lives than their parents.
