We have collected \$35.74 so far.

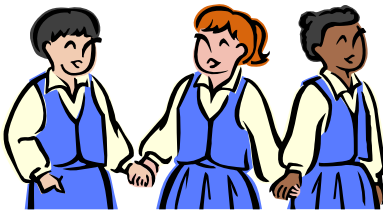

Loving Savior church is hosting a Women's Luncheon on Saturday, May 1st at 12:00 pm.

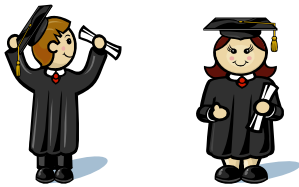
Everyone is welcome.

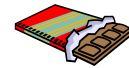
