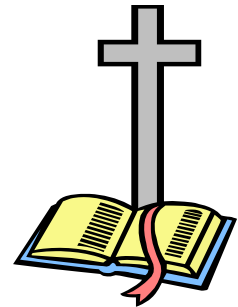

Housekeeping News:

1. Our WASC/NLSA Visit went very well! Praise God! The visiting team was very impressed with how well we did in our self-study and complimented us on our beautiful campus and facilities. They actually said we have some of the best and most beautiful facilities of any private school in Southern California. The team agreed with our new Action Plan and then added two additional goal suggestions. We will be rewriting our Action Plan to include these. We now have a list of several minor goals to work on, but our five major goals for the next six years are the following:
 - a. Increase professional development of our teaching staff in order to increase student learning.
 - b. Increase incorporation of our Expected Schoolwide Learning Results into every classroom and every lesson in order to increase student learning.
 - c. Develop a Master Resource Plan, including a Marketing Plan, to increase enrollment in order to spread the Gospel to more students and to support future school growth.
 - d. Write and develop full-scale Loving Savior Curriculum Guides in each grade in order to facilitate student learning and to improve articulation between grades.
 - e. Increase the number and variety of assessments used that provide disaggregated learning data in order to guide learning planning and decisions.

Thank you all for your hard work (especially in the Focus Groups!), prayers and support during this worthwhile process. We now have a road map and are ready to begin working on all of these goals, both minor and major!

Plan ahead now!

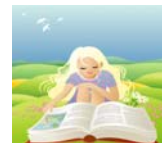
Our school will be closed the weeks of December 22nd – January 2nd.
